Prepping for CCTA:

*NPO 4 hours prior to testing-you can have a couple sips of water to take your medications.

*If you are a diabetic then you need a BUN and Creatinine (bloodwork) drawn. 1 month

* If you are 50 years or older then you need a BUN and Creatinine (bloodwork) drawn. 3 months

*Are you allergic to dye or iodine? If so, is it mild or severe? You may need medication if so.

Prepping for ablation:

***If instructed** you may need to stop taking your antiarrhythmic, calcium channel blockers, or beta blockers medications. (only if instructed by the Doctor)

*Discontinue Coumadin and Warfarin **5 days prior**.

*Discontinue Pradaxa, Xarelto, and Eliquis **1 day prior**.

*Discontinue Amiodarone, Verapamil, and Digoxin **4 days prior**.

*If you are instructed to stop your Coumadin or Warfarin you need to take Lovenox shots.

*Nothing to eat or drink 12 hours before the study, you can have a few sips of water to take your medications.

*Are you allergic to Dye?

Cannot drive for 2-3 days after the study so please arrange for any assistance you may need after.

Enclosed are the pretest orders (blood work) that needs to be done 3 to 7 days prior to the study.
